The CorBusiness Application Administration course is designed for individuals responsible for the installation, implementation, and administration of Rocket CorVu. It focuses on Knowledge Library development, which is the metadata layer between the CorVu software and the database being accessed. Additionally, security set-up and operation of the CorVu Scheduler is covered in this class.
